Helpful Tips for Teachers!

Hello fellow educators!

Not gonna lie, it's been a fast, rocky, beginning of the year - but I know that we have such a capable SPED staff at NUSD that things will start to smooth out soon. All of us in NFT are here to support you so please don't hesitate to reach out to your Elementary or Secondary SPED reps, or to me.

Here are a few pieces of information and tips with you to hopefully clear things up around scheduling IEP meetings:

- The district strongly encourages meetings to be held during the school day. However, they understand that sometimes that is not possible and meetings must be held at a different time.
- One General Education teacher needs to be at each IEP meeting, and stay for the duration of the meeting.
- Each individual meeting should last no longer than one hour. If at the end of one hour there is still more to discuss, stop the meeting, and schedule a follow up meeting for as soon as possible.
- Start each meeting with going over Norms. This will help meetings stay respectful and on topic (I have attached a Norm template for you to use or that you can use to help guide your own Norms).

Continue to lean on each other and know that you are valued!
